## APPLICANT PROCESS (please check with LID, Home Owner's Association (if applicable), and City of Lathrop for applicable fees):

SUBMIT PLANS TO HOME OWNER'S ASSOCIATION (HOA) FOR APPROVAL (IF APPLICABLE)

Currently only multi-unit residences (bungalows) require HOA approval. Applicant to provide HOA approval to LID

SUBMIT HOA APPROVAL (IF APPLICABLE), FEES, APPLICATION FORMS AND PLANS TO LATHROP IRRIGATION DISTRICT (LID) FOR APPROVAL

LID provides notice to applicant that plans are approved, applicant to provide approval notice to City of Lathrop with application for permit.

SUBMIT LID APPROVAL,
APPLICATION, FEES AND PLANS TO
CITY OF LATHROP FOR PERMIT

City to review and issue permit to applicant

UPON APPROVAL OF ALL AGENCIES AND RECEIPT OF PERMIT FROM CITY INSTALL SOLAR ARRAY AS APPROVED IN DESIGN PLAN

APPLICANT BEGINS INSTALLATION ONLY AFTER ALL REQUIRED APPROVALS ARE RECEIVED

REQUEST LID AND CITY INSPECTION
OF SOLAR (CONCURRENTLY) NOTE
THAT ONLY PERMIT APPLICANT CAN
SCHEDULE INSPECTION

Applicant requests solar inspection from LID (allow two to five business days for inspection). LID sends confirmation email and copies City of inspection time. Permittee to schedule concurrent appointment for final inspection with the City the day before scheduled inspection no later than 4 pm

FAILURE TO PASS INSPECTION WILL REQUIRE ADDITIONAL FEES AND NEW INSPECTION TO BE SCHEDULED WITH BOTH ENTITIES **SOLAR CONTRACTOR MUST BE IN ATTENDANCE AT INSPECTION**. Upon completion of inspection, LID issues certificate that installation is "as designed" approved and functional. City to sign final inspection that all relevant building codes and requirements are met. Solar Meter is set in place

PTO ISSUED BY LID-SOLAR METER CONFIGURED FOR SOLAR PRODUCTION CREDITS Once all entities have signed off, PTO is issued by LID and meter is configured to read bi-directionally. At this point customer will begin receiving credit for solar excess generation as set forth in the Interconnection Agreement
